**11. Resolution concerning Dr. and Mrs. Martin Luther King, Jr.**

Mr. Daniel R. Acker of New York moved the adoption of the following resolution. It was seconded and

69-GS-149 VOTED:

WHEREAS Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., was one of our greatest churchmen and one of our greatest ministers of the gospel; and

WHEREAS he was a great leader for civil rights and dignity for all human beings;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Seventh General Synod send a message to his widow, Mrs. Coretta King, complimenting her for carrying on his work and encouraging her to continue.
